



Elverta Community Sports Park

SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA

The Elverta Community Sports Park provides for the active recreational needs of a new 1,743-acre planned community and surrounding environs.

The 38 acre Elverta Community Sports Park anchors the active sports component of an overall recreation program associated with the 1,743 acre Elverta Specific Plan. Planned to service the organized recreation needs of the community, proposed facilities include three softball fields, two youth baseball fields, three soccer fields, four tennis courts, full court basketball and a children's play area. All fields and courts are planned to be lighted for evening use. Attendant park facilities include restrooms, a concession building and various shade

structures. Parking has been designed to be clustered close to associated uses, minimizing the need for a large singular lot. Clustered parking also provides for more convenient access to individual facilities and uses. Non-vehicular access is provided by an intra-community multi-purpose trail system that runs throughout the specific plan area. The park is furthermore bisected by a multi-use trail that follows a power line corridor allowing for unencumbered access from the County line to a planned connection with the Dry Creek recreation corridor.
